

Performing Arts Term Two 2017

SOME of the activities the students will be involved with in Performing Arts.

Prep:

Students explore ideas for characters and situations through dramatic play using masks, puppets and hats.

Year One:

Students use safe dance practice, fundamental locomotor and non-locomotor movements, body parts, bases and zones to explore, improvise and structure movement ideas for dance.

Year Two:

Students respond to dance, expressing what they enjoy, and where and why people dance.

Year Three:

Students identify how the elements of dance and production elements express ideas in dance they make, perform and view.

Year Four:

Students explore ideas and narrative structures through roles and situations and use empathy in their own improvisations and devised drama.

Year Five:

Students rehearse and perform songs and music they have learnt, including their own compositions, combining aspects of the elements of music and using performance skills, to communicate ideas and intentions to an audience in preparation for Grandparents Day.

Year Six:

Students rehearse songs and music they have learnt from Shrek Jnr, combining aspects of the elements of music and using performance skills, to communicate ideas and intentions to an audience.
