

Performing Arts Term 3 2018

SOME of the learning intentions the students will be involved with in Performing Arts.

Prep:

The students are learning to focus on imagining and creating characters, roles and situations.

Year One:

Students are learning to use their voice, facial expression, movement and space to imagine and establish role and situation.

Year Two:

Students are learning to create their characters and roles for their “Being Resilient” performance.

Year Three:

Students are learning to explore ideas and narrative structures through roles and situations.

Year Four:

Students are continuing to explore and experiment with their voice, body, movement and language to sustain a role and character.

Year Five:

Students are learning to explore dramatic actions, empathy and space in improvisations, play building and scripted drama to develop characters and situations.

Year Six:

Students are learning to develop their character for Lion King Jnr through voice and movement and extend their understanding and use of situation, focus, tension and space.
