



Student and Parent User Agreement
Guidelines for parents who are allowing their child to bring personal devices (as specified by the ICT Team) from home to use at school.

1. This is not intended to be a legally binding agreement.
2. Devices that are brought to and kept at school are used entirely at the owner's risk. The school cannot accept any responsibility for theft, loss or damage to such property.
3. It is expressly forbidden to film or take photographs of other individuals without their consent, or send harassing or threatening messages via a mobile device.
4. DET does not hold insurances for personal property brought to school and Beaumaris Primary School is not responsible for any loss or damage to such property.
5. You will take full responsibility for the observance of all Copyright requirements for any software Applications (Apps) that are installed.
6. Your mobile device may **not** be loaned to any other person.
7. You are not permitted to use your mobile device during recess or lunchtimes. It is to remain in the classroom in a location allocated by the classroom teacher.
8. There will be no technical support available for devices apart from the initial connection to the school network.
9. Beaumaris Primary School accepts no responsibility for any software (Apps), data etc. that you install. You are not permitted to install Applications (Apps) during school time unless specified by a teacher.
10. You will ensure that your mobile device is secured **at all times**. You will:
 - 10.1. Not leave it in classrooms on desks. Store it in a safe secure location in the classroom as directed by your teacher, when not in use.
 - 10.2. Ensure that your device is away from areas that could damage it, e.g. do not leave it close to a window where the sun could damage the screen.
11. You will abide by all ICT policies (e.g. Acceptable Use Agreement for ICT Policy) as established by Beaumaris Primary School concerning the use of Internet and other computing services provided by the school.
12. You will make sure your mobile device is fully charged at the commencement of each new day and are not permitted to bring a charger to school.
 - 12.1. Beaumaris Primary School will not be responsible for the damage of a mobile device charging cable should it be brought to the school.

I acknowledge my obligation to use the mobile device in a sensible and responsible manner for educational purposes. I understand that misuse of the mobile device may result in the imposition of school sanctions in line with the school's Acceptable Use Agreement for ICT.

I have read and agree to accept the above User Agreement in relation to the mobile device that is my own personal device and will be used for the BYOD program at Beaumaris Primary School during school times.
