<p>In Mathematics we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • subitise (recognise and copy a variety of dot patterns) – “what do you see and how do you see it?” • use counting strategies to solve problems that involve comparing, combining and separating sets (addition, subtraction and sharing) • correctly form numerals 0 - 9 • match individual objects with counting sequences up to and back from 20 • count backwards from numbers larger than 20 • estimate the size of collections up to 20 • connect number names for numerals up to 100 • explore place value, using the terms ‘tens’ and ‘ones’ • sort familiar categorical data into sets and create data displays • compare and order objects according to their weight and capacity • measure the mass and capacity of objects using informal units • sort shapes based on common features • make connections between addition and subtraction • identify and order Australian coins 	<p>In English we will be learning to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • read smoothly and with expression • make connections to stories • predict and retell the main idea in a story • blend sounds to read words • identify syllables in word • identify open and closed syllables in words • recognise rhyming words and copy rhyming patterns • form letters using <i>Vic Modern Cursive</i> (school font) • use full stops and capital letters correctly • identify vowels, consonants and digraphs (sh, wh, th, ch) • identify prefixes (un, re) and suffixes (ing, ed) • explore purpose of different text types (Letters, Narratives and Information Reports) • edit writing • speak clearly using appropriate volume and speed • ask simple questions in response to information • sequence ideas when speaking • use topic specific language when speaking • share our feelings and thoughts about characters and events in stories

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<p>Homework: Reading/ writing at home</p>	<p>Reading should be a special and enjoyable experience for all family members. It is expected students will read 4-5 times a week and the books be recorded in their reading log. Take home books are provided and children are also encouraged to borrow books from the local library.</p>																												

	Writing – please provide your child with writing materials, paper, glue and scissors to use at their leisure. Practise writing shopping lists, birthday cards or notes to friends.
Nude food lunches 	All students are encouraged to bring ‘nude food’ lunches. A nude food lunch has no foil, gladwrap or any other packaging. Please unwrap and throw any rubbish out at home, to help us significantly reduce the amount of rubbish scattered throughout our school. Please also provide a labelled drink bottle containing water for your child. Research shows that children learn best when they are well hydrated.
School Uniform	Our Beaumaris PS school uniform should be worn correctly and be in good condition. Please ensure all items of clothing are named . Check the lost property cupboard near the art room for any missing items. Please ensure hair longer than shoulder length (for girls and boys) is tied up and hair accessories are school colours only. Jewellery is not part of the Beaumaris PS school uniform, including coloured wrist and ankle bands. Students may only wear small stud earrings. School uniform is worn on excursions.
Sun smart	We encourage students to apply sunscreen before going to school. Extra sunscreen is available in the classroom. ‘Hats away, 1 st of May. 1 st of September, hats to remember’.
